We are pleased to announce that inaugural ceremony and 1st annual session of InCerS student chapter of NIT Rourkela is proposed to be held at NIT Rourkela on 6th – 7th April 2019 and will be hosted by the NIT Rourkela student chapter of the society.

The objective of the annual session is to provide a common forum for a large number of delegates from the field of ceramics to exchange thoughts and ideas and also to provide exposure to ceramic students from all over India.

TECHNICAL SESSION

1. Planery Lectures

Industrial delegates are invited for the same to share their words of wisdom on the current affairs related to their firm or to the concerned agenda the firm is working on: with a base solely contemplating on ceramic industry within a window of around half an hour. Lectures proposed for the aforementioned issue is on the basis of accountable registrations. Owing to the time precincts, the earliest of the registered delegates shall be entertained.

2. Panel discussions

Industrial delegates are also cordially welcomed to be a part of the panel within a two-hour window per discussion in a conference of tentatively 10 panellists (liable to changes depending on registrations). The agenda might include topics from both basic (refractory, glass etc.) and advanced ceramics (nano ceramics etc.) that inculcates on going agendas the firm might be working on.



STUDENT'S SESSION

1. PAPER/POSTER PRESENTATION

Students (B. Tech and M. Tech only) from all across the country are invited to present their paper/poster/presentation related to ceramic science/engineering. A time window of 10 minutes will be given to present the same and will be judged by a panel of experts. Cash prizes worth Rupees 8,000 will be provided to top three entries. 2. MODEL/PRODUCT PRESENTATION

Teams and individuals can present their ceramic based models during the event. Model or product may be in working or static condition. Originality should be maintained and kept in mind while developing models. Prizes worth thirteen thousand rupees will be awarded to top thirteen models or products.

3. QUIZ

Ceramic science/engineering based technical questions will be asked, maximum of five members can form a team and we will permit at most 5 teams. Early bird registration is advised. Prizes worth eight thousand rupees will be awarded to the top two teams.
